IN MEMORY...

Dorothy Hoag, CU PT Program Director from 1950 to 1972, died on February 7th at the age of 94. She was a member of the APTA since 1943 and began and funded a popular financial aide program for Colorado PT students.

During WWII, Dorothy served her country as a physical therapist for returning veterans wounded in action. She worked at the Fitzsimmons Army Hospital in Denver and used the knowledge she gained during this period to serve as technical advisor on the US Army film "**Towards Independence.**" The documentary was designed to help veterans learn to cope with their disabilities. The movie won the Best Documentary: Short Subject Oscar in 1948.
